1. Verification of weekly emails.
 - a. When children withdraw from Leopold, Emily will email Kris with email address to remove.
2. Leopold has been chosen as the recipient for funds from VH-1 for a Save the Music Grant. We are one of five schools slated to receive funds. Leopold will identify space (possibly a mobile lab) that could be housed in one of the music rooms. The grant pays for the keyboards, computers, headphones, and software to facilitate the program. The lab can accommodate up to 30 children that can be playing at a time. The equipment, which is estimated, to be worth approximately \$30,000 will not only benefits the music program, but could also allow for after school programs.
3. Leopold PFO has solidified the funding for new gym mats.
